- 4) If you are a teacher/leader submitting on behalf of a school or community group, you have permission from parents/guardians of all participants in the production to enter the film into the Cinemagic Young Filmmaker competition. If successful, permissions are in place for the names/images of children involved to be screened publicly at the festival.
