- 3) You have ensured you have the right to show the film to a public audience (i.e. secured all music and image rights / no outstanding copyright or licensing issues). If you do not have the permission to use the music/images in your film you cannot submit the film into the competition.
- 4) If you are a teacher/leader submitting on behalf of a school or community group you have permission from parents/guardians of all participants in the production to enter the film into the Cinemagic Young Filmmaker competition. If successful, permissions are in place for the names/images of children involved to be screened publicly at the festival.
